

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAX FOR THE YEAR 2025 SETTING SPECIFIC TAX RATES, APPLICABLE TO ALL REAL, PERSONAL AND MIXED PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE ROBERTSON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT, SETTING DUE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND INTEREST ON DELINQUENT TAXES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Robertson County Emergency Services District, Robertson County, Texas.

- (1) That an ad valorem tax rate of \$.07290 per \$100.00 cash valuation and assessment ratio of 100% of market value, as said values are fixed by the Board of Review, and the same is hereby levied for the year 2024 on all real property, personal property, and mixed property located and situated within the confines and boundaries of Robertson County Emergency Services District as of January 1 of this tax year.
- (2) That the above specified ad valorem tax rate be distributed as follows:
 - (a) \$.06690 rate for local maintenance fund

THE TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.45 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$1000,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$-3.15.

- (b) \$ 0.00600 rate for debt service, bonded indebtedness, interest and sinking fund
